Cool Milk & Fruit for Schools

Pupil Premium

The school receives an additional premium for the following children:

- Children whose parent/s are in the armed forces
- Children who receive free school meals (other than universal)
- Children who are looked after *

* Those who are subject to a care order or temporarily classed as looked after on a planned basis for short breaks or respite care.

Completion of a Pupil Premium form guarantees you a free school book bag at the start of the year.

Holidays will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances

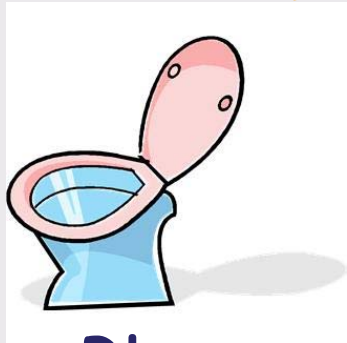
A fine may be issued - £60 per child, per parent

What is Nursery ready?

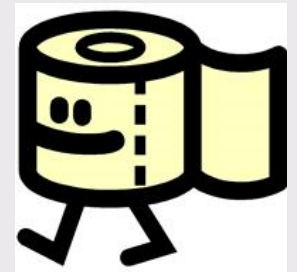
- Children to be drinking from cups and not bottles
- No dummies - this is particularly important during waking hours when children are better talkers without these.
- No pushchairs - we need to be building stamina.

Toilet Training



Please make every effort to have your child toilet trained before they start Nursery.

If you need some help with this or feel your child has medical need please contact the school office.





What is meant by school readiness?

Public Health England's definition includes:

- Have good oral health
- Develop motor control and balance for a range of physical activities
- Are independent in eating
- Are well nourished and within normal weight for height
- Have received all childhood immunisations
- Are able to take turns, sit, listen and play



Early Learning



How we create the classes

- We will contact your child's Nursery and collect any paperwork that needs to be collected. We will have a brief discussion with your child's current key worker.
- Your child will attend 3 induction dates (details on the next slide).
- During this time the Foundation Stage team will play with the children and make observations
- Using these observations and any other information received we will then allocate classes for the children. This will either be Apple or Cherry class.
- You will be informed by the end of this academic year.

- Wednesday 6th July - 9.15am - 11.15am
- Tuesday 12th July - 9.00am - 11.00am

September

- School opens Monday 5th September 2022 - all children will stay until 1pm.
- Monday 12th September all children will stay for the whole day 8:40 am to 3:00pm
