

- 2 times a week (Wednesday and Thursday

- * PE Kits- named please

- * Need to be kept in school from Monday-Friday
- * Children will be given spare kit to join in lessons if they do not have their kit
- * Small draw-string bags only
- * PE is a compulsory subject therefore a letter, email or phone call is needed if children are unable to participate.

Reading

- * Children will be grouped differently across the cohort for 30 mins of guided reading each day in order to best meet their needs.
- * Library Books should be changed regularly and this is the child's responsibility.
- * Reading should be recorded in children's reading records and celebrated in school on a Friday.
- * Reading every day is essential
- * It is important that children read a range of different types of genre/texts we will be monitoring the range of text types in school.



Maths

- * As in reading, children will be grouped differently across the cohort in order to best meet their needs.
- * Arithmetic skills will be crucially important in order to access the Y6 Maths curriculum.
- * Please continue to encourage your children to practise their times tables up to 12 x 12-Times Tables Rock Stars is perfect for this!
- * Also continue to reinforce telling the time at home!

Spellings

- * Weekly spellings will be sent home next week these will be tested on Tuesdays as before.
- * It is important they learn these as they cover the KS2 Spelling rules and patterns that will be assessed at the end of the year.
- * We are looking for them to be using these words in their writing consistently.
- * Spelling interventions

Homework

- Homework format will stay the same at first and we will transition into weekly homework further in the year in order to prepare the children for secondary expectations.
- * Published on website
- * Due in the last week of term
- * Shared with the class and marked by the teacher
- * Homework is often used on display
- * 1 of 3 options to choose
