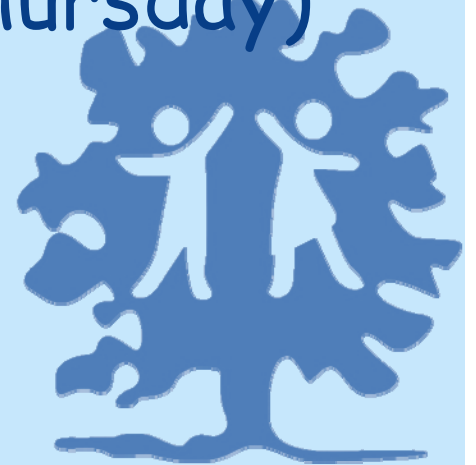

- \* PE is a compulsory subject therefore a letter, email or phone call is needed if children are unable to participate.





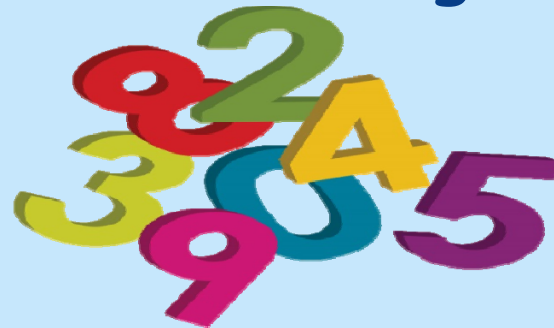
# Reading

- \* Children will be grouped differently across the cohort for 30 mins of guided reading each day in order to best meet their needs.
- \* Library Books should be changed regularly and this is the child's responsibility.
- \* Reading should be recorded in children's reading records and celebrated in school on a Friday.
- \* Reading every day is essential
- \* It is important that children read a range of different types of genre/texts - we will be monitoring the range of text types in school.



# Maths

- \* As in reading, children will be grouped differently across the cohort in order to best meet their needs.
- \* Arithmetic skills will be crucially important in order to access the Y6 Maths curriculum.
- \* Please continue to encourage your children to practise their times tables up to  $12 \times 12$ - Times Tables Rock Stars is perfect for this!
- \* Also continue to reinforce telling the time at home!



# Spellings

- \* Weekly spellings will be sent home next week - these will be tested on Tuesdays as before.
- \* It is important they learn these as they cover the KS2 Spelling rules and patterns that will be assessed at the end of the year.
- \* We are looking for them to be using these words in their writing consistently.
- \* Spelling interventions



# Homework

- \* Homework format will stay the same at first and we will transition into weekly homework further in the year in order to prepare the children for secondary expectations.
- \* Published on website
- \* Due in the last week of term
- \* Shared with the class and marked by the teacher
- \* Homework is often used on display
- \* 1 of 3 options to choose
