Dear Parents/Carers,

This afternoon, we launched 'The Little Book of Adventures' in all year groups at Red Oaks.

The Little Book of Adventures is inspired by lists such as '50 things to do before you're 11 $^{3/4}$.' The aim is to give all pupils the opportunity to try new things and develop new skills to equip them for life. It can help children to grow in confidence, expand their understanding of the world around them or introduce a hobby or passion that could last for years to come. It is designed to be lots of fun!



Each year group has a list of 20 ideas to complete over the year. These experiences can be done at home or in school. We aim for at least 15 of the 20 in each year group list to be completed at school but they can certainly be done more than once. Every child has an A5 booklet with all year group lists in that will stay with them throughout their journey at Red Oaks. This booklet will remain in school and will be signed off by the teacher as they complete activities. The full booklet can be found on the website under 'Children-Little Book of Adventures.'

You will find your child's year group list in the back of their Home School Contact Book to be able to complete lots of activities at home too. When your child has completed one of their year group activities, they can share their experience with the teacher and have it signed off. You don't have to record doing the activity in any way. However, if you would like to, we would love to see pictures, videos or models on Class Dojo or brought into school!

The challenge is to try and tick off all of the experiences before you leave Red Oaks in Year 6.
