Home/School Agreement COVID-19



School

The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection following Government guidelines;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays any symptom/s of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to selfisolate for at least 14 days;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy (with Covid-19 annex), as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email, Dojo and the school website.

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- ➤ If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone/email;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone/email;
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules;
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child and only one adult will accompany my child;
- My child will only bring in a lunch box (where required), water bottle and coat/sun hat and PE kit (that will remain at school);
- ➤ I will not be allowed into the school contact will be through email or phone;
- ➤ I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time;
- ➤ I will communicate effectively with school and inform them of any changes to emergency contacts details. I will also read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will I will follow social distancing rules at all times, and understand if there is evidence that I am not respecting social distancing rules, I may be required to stay off school premises;
- If my child is deemed unwell, the offer of school based learning will be revoked and remote learning will be offered until they are safe to return.

Child



I have to arrive at school at exactly the right time, so I will get ready quickly to leave the house.



I am only allowed to have one adult bring me to school and I must walk sensibly and not run around the playground.



I must follow the 'Bubble' rules that keep me and everyone else safe.



I will only bring in a water bottle, a lunch box and coat/sun hat and PE kit (that will remain at school).



I won't bring things in from home or take things home from school (including toys and pencil cases).



I must leave my bike or scooter in the racks by Abbey Park but will only bring if absolutely necessary.



I will follow the special tape markings on the floor and signs which tell me where my adult and I should go.



I need to try and stay 2m apart from other children and parents, including when I line up.



I will say goodbye to my adult on the playground and bring myself in independently because I am so grown up!



I will wash my hands properly whenever I am asked to. I will practise at home.



I will listen carefully to my grownup's instructions about what I can and cannot use during day and where I am allowed to sit and play.



I will follow the class rule about asking to go to the toilet as only one person may go at a time.



If I feel unwell, I will tell an adult.



I will follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' rules. Coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue.



I will not share my toys, equipment or food but I will share a smile!
