#### Dear Parents/Carers

We hope you have all had an amazing Christmas break. This term's enquiry title is 'What makes our world great?' We will be spending the term researching famous explorers. The children will be finding out about famous people such as Amelia Earhart and Captain James Cook. Alongside this they will be exploring incredible places around the world and comparing different climates. In science, the children will be investigating animals and their habitats.

## Morning Routine

#### PE

The homework will continue to be sent home at the beginning of every term. There are lots of activities on the sheet but if you can think of any more please show us in your books! Spellings will be given out on a Monday to be tested the following Monday.

### SATs

KS1 SATs will be taking place during w/c 11<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> May. The children will still have a normal school day and will be unaware that they are undertaking pieces of work that will then be assessed. Please make sure that children arrive as promptly as possible and have had a good breakfast on these days. We will be holding a year 2 SATs meeting for parents shortly where we will go through our expectations and answer any questions you may have.
