We will start and end our learning in our Forest/Pond area and we will hopefully be able to finish off with some bush skills and cooking. We are currently trying to organise a trip for later in the year but we will need to keep you informed about our progress.

Daily reminders:

- Please ensure that your child always brings a **water bottle** and a hat to school this term. Children should dress appropriately for the weather adhering to school uniform policy.

Homework will continue to be set termly and will be shared and celebrated in class at the end of each term. In year 4, we have high expectations of children with regards to homework and we ask that every child completes their chosen task in full and to the highest standards expected in class.
